

Professional Services No. 0623

The State of Wyoming, Water Development Commission (WWDC), is seeking professional services to perform water resources studies in accordance with W.S. 9-2-1030. The projects for which the services are sought are listed by study level. The WWDC, at its sole discretion, may request the selected consultant to provide additional services for Level I or Level II studies.

LEVEL I STUDIES (W.S. 41-2-114) -- New Development

The completion date for all Level I studies -- New Development is August 1, 2013.

Bear River Hydrology Model: A StateMod hydrology model will be developed for the Wyoming Bear River Basin. The consultant will assist WWDC in data acquisition, development of data management tools, and model development and calibration. Proposed budget: \$48,000. Contact: Dave Myer.

Guernsey Master Plan: Proposed budget: \$123,000. Contact: Dave Myer.

Lovell Master Plan: Proposed budget: \$108,000. Contact: Chace Tavelli.

Sheridan Supplemental Storage: Analysis of acquisition of Saw Mill Reservoir and purchase of Park Reservoir shares for use as municipal water supplies, including structural integrity and rehabilitation costs. Proposed budget: \$247,000. Contact: Mike Besson.

REQUIRED SUBMITTALS AND SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

Prospective consultants and subconsultants who have not submitted a Statement of Qualification to the Wyoming Water Development Commission since May 1, 2011, must complete and submit three (3) paper copies of a Statement of Qualification consisting of a letter of transmittal and a completed standard form 254. Prospective consultants and subconsultants may include any supplemental information deemed appropriate with their Statement of Qualification. **Please provide an e-mail address for distribution of RFP's and correspondence related to this process.**

Firms or individuals wishing to be considered as prime consultants must submit three (3) copies of a Statement of Interest, consisting of a letter of transmittal and a completed standard form 255, **for each project** the consultant is interested in pursuing. Copies of **UPDATED** standard forms 254 and 255 may be accessed on the WWDC website at <http://wwdc.state.wy.us> or by contacting the WWDO directly.

Consultants requested to prepare proposals will be selected by the WWDC, as per W.S. 9-2-1031, using information contained in the Statements of Qualification of the prime consultant and any subconsultants, and the Statement of Interest of the prime consultant.

Presently, the WWDC is seeking authorization for these projects from the 2012 Legislature. If authorization is not granted, the consultant selection process will be discontinued. The project applications and recommendations to the 2012 Legislature are available for review at the WWDO.

The Statements of Qualification and Statements of Interest must be received by the WWDC no later than **2:00 p.m. on February 7, 2012.** This notice may be accessed on the WWDC website at <http://wwdc.state.wy.us>
